

"World Antimicrobial Awareness Week" Celebration in AIIMS Rishikesh with Advices

- 1) Antimicrobial is running out: save it
- Antimicrobial can be saved: Do not take without order of a doctor
- 3) Antimicrobial resistance is increasing: acknowledge it
- 4) Resistance can be curtailed: Do not use where not indicated like viral infection, Do not under use antimicrobials, Do not use leftover antibiotics
- 5) Best method to save Antimicrobial and curtailed Resistance: Use of Hand hygiene, Cough hygiene, Effective waste treatment, and timely Vaccination
