

Invitation for 7th National Antimicrobial Stewardship Quiz Competition (Elimination Round)

General Rules

- 1. A team shall consist of 3 participants One SR, One JR, One Intern either from the same department or from different departments (Clinical/Lab). Participants from different departments will be preferred in case two teams score the same points. In rare situations, two participants can be allowed; however, both should be from different sections as above.
- 2. Following the completion of the local round, there will now be two upcoming rounds:
 - i) LOCAL (Institutional) ROUND: Local rounds have been completed.
 - ii) NATIONAL ELIMINATION ROUND: Conducted by ASPICON 2025 team of AIIMS Mangalagiri organizers among selected local teams (Date and other details will be shared to local team winner) to decide best 6 national teams. Only the first winning team from each local round is eligible to participate in this elimination round.
 - iii) NATIONAL STAGE ROUND: Conducted by ASPICON 2025 team of AIIMS Mangalagiri organiser among selected 6 teams (Date and other details will be shared to team winner.)
- 3. All questions will be the same/uniform for all participating doctors.
- **4.** The quiz pattern will be multiple-choice questions (MCQs) with a single best answer and a negative marking of 1/3rd for first two rounds.
- 5. One Local institute faculty coordinators of the winning teams are requested to share details of the eligible team (first prize winner) only to the central SASPI team and local ASPICON 2025 coordinators via mail/WhatsApp with participating team names, a leader name, and their participating mail IDs. Only these teams will be allowed to attend the quiz. To help them, one google form is shared in flyer to be filled by individual local teams for local round participation.
- 6. The faculty coordinator shall email their team member details to the attached email before 2nd April (5 PM) to receive the quiz link before the exam begins.
- 7. Results will be shared with the faculty coordinator by 10th April (5 PM).
- **8.** Free registrations will be provided to top 6 institute teams after Elimination round with all local team winners before the ASPICON stage round.

Note: Local rounds have concluded. This flyer is for the Elimination Round phase only.



Invitation for 7th National Antimicrobial Stewardship Quiz Competition (Preliminary Round)

General Rules

1. A team shall consist of 3 participants – One SR, One JR, One Intern – either from the same department or from different departments (Clinical/Lab). Participants from different departments will be preferred in case two teams score the same points. In rare situations, two participants can be allowed; however, both should be from different sections as above.

2. There will be three rounds:

- i) LOCAL (Institutional) ROUND: Conducted through parent institutes (Invited National Medical Colleges) throughout the country by ASPICON 2025. The central organizing team will provide the quiz questions to the local coordinator 10 minutes before the finalized quiz timing based on their feasibility. If the local team prefers, they can join the competition through an online Google quiz on 7th April at 2 PM sharp. At least three teams per institute are required to conduct a local round.
- ii) NATIONAL ELIMINATION ROUND: Conducted by ASPICON 2025 team of AIIMS Mangalagiri organiser among selected local teams (Date and other details will be shared to local team winner) to decide best 6 national teams.
- iii) NATIONAL STAGE ROUND: Conducted by ASPICON 2025 team of AIIMS Mangalagiri organiser among selected 6 teams (Date and other details will be shared to team winner.)
- 3. All questions will be the same/uniform for all participating doctors.
- 4. The quiz pattern will be multiple-choice questions (MCQs) with a single best answer and a negative marking of 1/3rd for first two rounds.
- 5. One local institute faculty coordinator will contact central SASPI team and local ASPICON 2025 coordinators via mail/WhatsApp with participating team names, a leader name, and their participating mail IDs. Only these teams will be allowed to attend the quiz. To help them, one google form is shared in flyer to be filled by individual local teams for local round participation.
